Nurse Aide Program Fact Sheet

The program consists of 64 hours of lecture and lab in 8 classes and 56 hours of clinical in 7 days. Upon completion of the CNA Program you will have the skills and knowledge needed to work in a long-term care facility as a nurse aide. You will also be eligible to take the Pennsylvania Nurse Aide competency exam. The Rapha School, LLC. Is a licensed exam center so you will be able to take the exam at the schools location.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Completed school application
- \$950 check or money order to The Rapha School, LLC. for the cost of the program or an agreement from a long-term care facility if paying for your class
 - The \$950 tuition includes your criminal record check, skills pack, and book
- Verification of PA Residency
 - This can be completed during class orientation or on the first day of class. You must be able to provide us with Proof of Residency with a valid state ID, license, or Passport. These items must have been no earlier than two years prior to your application. If these items do not date back two years, you must provide us with another document (i.e. bank statement, utility bill) dating back two years, covering the unverified time of your other ID.
- PA Criminal History Record Information (CHRI) Report
 - This will be completed by The Rapha School, LLC.
- Physical exam performed no more than a year prior to application. This exam must include:
 - Evidence of being free of any communicable diseases and ability to lift 50 lbs
 - Evidence of a negative 2-step Mantoux or negative QuantiFeron®-TB Gold. The second Mantoux must be administered between 7-12 days of the first test.
- Evidence of a high school diploma or GED
- The candidate will need basic math, reading, and writing skills in English
